TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.

- 1. NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
- 2. NO CAMERAS or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
- 3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
- 4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for <u>absolute emergencies only</u> (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
- 5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
- 6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

For TWUSA performances at The Lehman Center, please plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes before curtain time.

From New Jersey, Manhattan East, Queens or Brooklyn - take the George Washington Bridge, Willis Avenue Bridge, or the Triborough Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway north (I-87) and exit at Van Cortlandt Park South.(Follow directions below for Van Cortlandt Park South exit)



From Manhattan West - take the West Side Highway north (becomes Henry Hudson Parkway to Mosholu Parkway exit. (Follow directions below for Mosholu Parkway exit)

From Westchester - take the New York State Thruway to the Major Deegan Expressway south (I-87) to Van Cortlandt Park South. (becomes Henry Hudson Parkway) to Mosholu Parkway exit. (Follow directions below for Mosholu Parkway exit)

Commercial vehicles should take the Major Deegan Expressway.

VAN CORTLANDT PARK SOUTH EXIT

At traffic light, turn left and proceed up the hill (bearing left with the main road) past Sedgwick Avenue, until you reach Goulden Avenue. Proceed on Goulden for two long blocks and make a left onto Bedford Park Boulevard West. Continue to the intersection of Bedford Park Boulevard West and Paul Avenue, where you can enter through Gate 8. Continue through the gate and down Paul Avenue to the front of the Concert Hall.

MOSHOLU PARKWAY EXIT

Proceed on long exit ramp to the second traffic light. At traffic light turn right into the center of a traffic island. Continue straight ahead on Paul Avenue for two blocks to Bedford Park Boulevard West. At Bedford Park Boulevard West, you can enter through Gate 8 and continue down Paul Avenue to the front of the Concert Hall.
