TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.

- 1. NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
- 2. NO CAMERAS or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
- 3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
- 4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for <u>absolute emergencies only</u> (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
- 5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
- 6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

For TWUSA performances at the Dothan Civic Center, please plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before curtain time.

For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times and sit only where you are instructed to do so. PLEASE make sure that your children fill every seat, not leaving any empties between them.

BUS ARRIVAL: Buses should go to the back of the Civic Center and enter on E. Troy Street (northside of Civic Center) (One-way). They should pull to stop sign at St. Andrews Street intersection. Both lanes will be utilized. Bus Drivers should pull their buses as close as possible to the bus in front to prevent students from passing between the buses. DCC representatives will be directing buses and a walkway will be established. Teachers should keep children on the bus until an usher (DCC rep) comes to take them off the bus. It will be first comefirst seated. At the end of the performance, the groups will be dismissed by bus numbers in order to expedite the departure.

<u>UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES</u> are parents/chaperones allowed to enter the arena prior to the students' arrival to save seats.

<u>VANS/PRIVATE VEHICLES</u>: Arriving vehicles should park in the south parking lot and, in a group, walk to the southside door and wait there for an usher(DCC rep).
