TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.

- 1. NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
- 2. NO CAMERAS or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
- 3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
- 4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for <u>absolute emergencies only</u> (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
- 5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
- 6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Your Performance Location

The STATE THEATER CENTER for the ARTS at 452 Northampton Street in Easton, PA

For TWUSA performances at The State Theater Center for the Arts, doors open approximately 30 minutes before curtain time. Please plan to arrive at least 10 minutes ahead. To avoid traffic problems, afternoon groups should not arrive more than 35 minutes before show time.

Directions

From Points East (New Jersey): Take 22 West to 2nd Exit (Lafayette College/Downtown Easton) after toll bridge in PA. Turn left onto Third Street. Proceed to monument. At the circle, go 1/4 around to Northampton Street West. The theatre is located on the right.

From Points West (Allentown/Bethlehem): Take 22 East to 4th Street Exit in Easton. Follow 4th Street to the second traffic light and turn right onto Northampton Street West. The theatre is located on the right. Or take 78 East to the Easton Exit. Turn left onto Morgon Hill Road. At stop sign continue straight. At the stop light bear left onto St. John Street and follow into downtown Easton. Proceed to the monument and go 3/4 around to Northampton Street West. The theatre is located on the right.

From Points South (Riegelsville, Doylestown): Take 611 North and turn at the light onto 3rd Street. Proceed to the monument and go 3/4 around onto Northampton Street West. The theatre is located on the right.
