TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. **Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.**

1. **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
2. **NO CAMERAS** or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for absolute emergencies only (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Your Performance Location

For TWUSA performances at the Haugh Performing Arts Center, plan to arrive 20 to 30 minutes before curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes prior to curtain time. Once your entire party has arrived, please check in with the Haugh House Manager outside the lobby entrance.

While there are **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby (including bagged lunches and coolers), **there are areas just outside the lobby where lunches may be dropped off and picked up after the show.**

Seating at this location is on a first-checked-in, first-served basis. You will be given a number after checking in. Check-in is outside the main lobby doors. Please follow the instructions of the house staff at all time and please make sure that your children fill every seat, not leaving any empties between them.

Please Note: Patrons arriving in cars should be advised that parking on campus is extremely limited, and **no longer free**. Arriving cars will need to **purchase a one day permit**, and allow plenty of time to park. The only spaces likely to be found may be in the **auxiliary parking lot I - 1/4 mile away** (see attached map), and about a 10 minute walk to the Center. During the **weekdays, it is \$5 to park private cars. Permits can be purchased at the yellow automated kiosk beside the box office, at the entrance to campus on Citrus (where the big marquee is).** Please note the price to park is subject to change.
