TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. **Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.**

1. **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
2. **NO CAMERAS** or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for absolute emergencies only (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Your Performance Location

The Chabot College Performing Arts Center at 25555 Hesperian Blvd. in Hayward, California.

For TWUSA performances at the Chabot College Performing Arts Center, please plan to arrive at least **45 minutes** before curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes before curtain time. But venue would like to have everyone seated and ready for the performance to start on time.

Seating: please make sure that your children fill every seat, not leaving any empties between them.

Parking:

For Buses-- buses can pull through lot H and **drop the kids off. Buses must find parking off campus.**

For Cars— cars can park in Lot G, but please be aware that there is a \$2/day fee (fee subject to change). There are kiosks to pay and the kiosks only take cash. If there is a problem with the kiosk, please let the House Manager know.

Directions: From **Highway 880 North or South** take the **Jackson St / San Mateo Bridge Hwy92** off-ramp heading West towards the San Mateo Bridge. Take the first off-ramp, **HESPERIAN Blvd** and take the **LEFT** exit (North). As you exit stay in the far left lane and make a left at the first light onto **DEPOT Road**. You may now make a right into any of the parking lots on your right (**Lots G & F**) and follow signs to the PAC (Theater).

From the **Peninsula / Hwy 101, 280**, take **Hwy92 San Mateo / Hayward Bridge** East to Hayward. Exit at **HESPERIAN Blvd** and turn left at the light. Proceed over the overpass, make a left at the first light onto **DEPOT Rd.** and then turn right into parking lots **G or F**.

From **Hwy 580** take **Hwy238 connector to Hwy880 South**. From there follow instructions above "From **Hwy880 North or South**. **On the campus map below, the "Performing Arts Center" is indicated as Building 1300.**
