TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. **Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.**

1. **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
2. **NO CAMERAS** or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for absolute emergencies only (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Your Performance Location

The La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts in La Mirada California

For TWUSA performances at the La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts, please plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes before curtain time.

La Mirada Theatre is centrally located near the intersection of La Mirada Boulevard and Rosecrans Avenue. – A 20 minute drive from downtown Los Angeles, Disneyland, and Knott's Berry Farm. Parking is free.

NO Backpacks are permitted in the venue.

Please see the House Manager for instructions and directions to where groups can take students to have lunch.

Seating: Please make sure that your children fill every seat, not leaving any empties between them.

From Los Angeles, Hollywood, Santa Monica, San Fernando Valley, Burbank:

Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) South
Exit Rosencrans
Right (East) on Rosencrans for approximately 3 miles
Right on La Mirada Boulevard. The Theatre is on the left side of the street.

From Orange County, Santa Ana, Anaheim, Mission Viejo, San Diego, Laguna:

Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) North
Exit Valley View
Left on Firestone, Right on Valley View
Continue on Valley View one long block to Alondra Boulevard
Right on Alondra for approximately 2 miles
Left on La Mirada Boulevard. The Theatre is on the right side of the street

From Long Beach, South Bay Area, Torrance, Manhattan Beach, Hawthorne:

Artesia Freeway (91) East (toward Riverside)
Exit Beach Boulevard
Left on Beach Boulevard for approximately 3 miles
Left on La Mirada Boulevard for approximately 1 mile. The Theatre is on the right side of the street.

From Riverside, Norco, Corona, Hemet, El Cerrito:

Artesia Freeway (91) West (toward Long Beach)
Exit Beach Boulevard
Right on Beach Boulevard approximately 3 miles
Left on La Mirada Boulevard for approximately 1 mile. The Theatre is on the right side of the street.

From San Bernardino, Pomona, Ontario:

Orange Freeway (57) South (toward Newport Beach)
Exit Imperial Highway



Right on Imperial Highway for approximately 7-8 miles
Left on La Mirada Boulevard for approximately 1 mile. The Theatre is on the left side of the street.

From Pasadena, San Gabriel Valley, West Covina, Alhambra:

San Gabriel Freeway (605) South to Santa Ana Freeway (I-5)
South on I-5 Freeway for approximately 2-3 miles
Exit Rosencrans
Right on Rosencrans (East) for approximately 3 miles
Right on La Mirada Boulevard. The Theatre is on the left side of the street

From Hacienda Heights:

Hacienda Boulevard to Colima Road
West on Colima Road
After crossing Lambert Road, take the left fork onto La Mirada Boulevard
Continue South on La Mirada Boulevard. The Theatre is on the left side of the street.
