TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. **Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.**

1. **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
2. **NO CAMERAS** or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for absolute emergencies only (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

For TWUSA performances at the JOHN LYMAN CENTER at Southern Connecticut State University, please plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes before curtain time.

Directions:

From New York, take I-95 and use Exit 44. Bear right onto Kimberly Avenue, Route 10. Turn left at stoplight onto Ella Grasso Boulevard which ends at Crescent Street. Turn left and enter the second driveway on the right at the information booth.

From New London, use I-95 and take Exit 45. Bear right onto Ella Grasso Boulevard which ends at Crescent Street. Turn left and enter the first driveway on the right.

Drop off is at the theatre door. When dismissed, groups will be escorted on campus sidewalks and across the student footbridge to the pick-up point at Farnham Avenue to find the buses. (Approx. distance – 2 blocks) Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions.



Dear Field Trip Teacher,

Thank you for choosing to bring your students to a performance at Lyman Center. We need your help to make the theatrical experience for your group as pleasant as possible. Please arrive at least 20 minutes prior to curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes prior to curtain. We ask that you review the following with your colleagues, chaperones, parents and students prior to your trip.

DROP OFF AND DISMISSAL:

Drop off is at the front lobby of the theatre. Arrival and dismissal is an organized procedure; Please follow the direction of university personnel. Guests are dismissed according to their sections in the theater.

Dismissed groups will be escorted on campus sidewalks and across the student footbridge to the pick up point –at Farnham Avenue to board the buses. (approx. distance- 2 blocks) **Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions.**

PERSONS BRINGING CARS OR VANS ONTO SCSU CAMPUS:

Please be advised that due to ongoing construction and classes, parking on campus is very limited. Parking near the Lyman Center may not be available to your group.

You will be able to drop off your students at the Lyman Center (if you plan on dropping off, please have a second adult to stay with your students). Check with the university police officer at the front the theatre for available parking.

Please give yourself extra time to allow for parking on campus.

FOOD AND LUNCH FACILITIES:

NO REFRESHMENTS OF ANY KIND (including sandwiches, candy bars, potato chips, lifesavers, and especially GUM) are permitted inside the theatre.

The John Lyman Center and SCSU do not have lunch facilities available and picnicking on the campus is not permitted.
