TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.

- 1. NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
- 2. NO CAMERAS or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
- 3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
- 4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for <u>absolute emergencies only</u> (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
- 5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
- 6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Coming by Bus





Upon arrival, Police Officers will greet you and direct your bus

Remind the students to dress for the weather.




Coming by Car

You may park in the Pioneer parking deck on Main Street across from the theater.




1. Look for the theater entrance with your school name.

FROM NORTH: From I-90 East

Follow I-90 to US Business Route 20 West (E. State St.) exit [*see optional route below]. Merge onto E. State St. and follow for approximately 7 miles through town. Turn right (north) onto Jefferson St. (BP Station/McDonalds is at northeast corner of intersection, on right). Follow Jefferson St. across river to the second traffic light. Turn right on to Wyman. If you are driving by car you may park in the parking deck here. If you are driving by bus the street will turn left onto Park. At Main Street turn Left so you are heading south on Main Street. Theatre will be on the right.

FROM SOUTH: From I-39 North

Follow I-39 North to US Route 20 West (Freeport-5 Rockford Exits). Follow US Route 20 to the third exit, IL Route 2 North (Main St.). Exit right (north) and follow Main St. for approximately 2 miles where IL Route 2 splits to the right onto Wyman St. Follow Wyman St. You will pass Jefferson. If you are driving by car you may park in the parking deck here. If you are driving by bus the street will turn left onto Park. At Main Street turn Left so you are heading south on Main Street. Theatre will be on the right.

FROM EAST: From I-90

If coming on I-90 from Chicago or Wisconsin, take the East State Street exit (Business Route 20). Merge right (west) onto East State Street and follow for approximately 7 miles through town. Continue to follow the marked Business 20 route through the downtown area. Turn right onto Jefferson Street (BP Station/McDonalds is on your right). Follow Jefferson Street across river to the first traffic light

Turn right on to Wyman. If you are driving by car you may park in the parking deck here. If you are driving by bus the street will turn left onto Park. At Main Street turn Left so you are heading south on Main Street. Theatre will be on the right.

FROM I-88

Take I-88 west to I-39 North. Follow I-39 North to US Route 20 West (Freeport-5 Rockford Exits). Follow US Route 20 to the third exit, IL Route 2 North (Main St.). Exit right (north) and follow Main St. for approximately 2 miles where IL Route 2 splits to the right onto Wyman St. Follow Wyman St. You will pass Jefferson. If you are driving by car you may park in the parking deck here. If you are driving by bus the street will turn left onto Park. At Main Street turn Left so you are heading south on Main Street. Theatre will be on the right.

FROM WEST

Take US Route 20 East to US Business Route 20 East (W. State St.) [* see optional route below]. Follow W. State St. east for approximately 6 miles until you reach Wyman St. Turn left onto Wyman St You will pass Jefferson. If you are driving by car you may park in the parking



deck here. If you are driving by bus the street will turn left onto Park. At Main Street turn Left so you are heading south on Main Street. Theatre will be on the right.

* To avoid the traffic signals of W. State St. remain on US Route 20 until the IL Route 2 North (Main St.) exit. Follow Main St. north for approximately 2 miles where IL Route 2 splits to the right onto Wyman St. Follow Wyman St. to fifth traffic signal, W. Jefferson St. Go past Jefferson. If you are driving by car you may park in the parking deck here. If you are driving by bus the street will turn left onto Park. At Main Street turn Left so you are heading south on Main Street. Theatre will be on the right.
