TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. **Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.**

1. **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
2. **NO CAMERAS** or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for absolute emergencies only (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Your Performance Location

For TWUSA performances at the Tarrytown Music Hall, plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before curtain time.

IF YOUR GROUP IS SCHEDULED TO ATTEND THE 12PM PERFORMANCE, PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 11:30AM AS YOU MAY HINDER THE DISMISSAL OF THE 10AM SHOW. If you happen to arrive prior to 11:30 am, your bus may wait in the parking area by the Tarrytown Lakes or circle the block.

- 1) When you arrive at the theater, please STAY on your bus until the bus director signs you in.
- 2) Teachers, **please remember your bus number as you will be dismissed by bus, not by school.**
- 3) **After dropping students off, buses will be directed to an off-site parking area (see maps on following pages) and will be given a time to return to the theater for pick up. Please follow the instructions of the Police Officer and Bus Director.**
- 4) Please fill every seat.
- 5) Please seat adults on the aisles and ask them to sit a little lower in their seats, if necessary, so children may have the best visibility.
- 6) At the end of the show, please remain seated until your bus number is called.
- 7) If you would like to visit a park after the performance, they are located at:
 - 1) West Main Street near the Hudson River
 - 2) Broadway and College Avenue near the Warner Library
 - 3) Neperan Road and Grove Street

The Music Hall is centrally located in Tarrytown, 20 miles north of New York City.

It is accessible by local and express trains (Metro-North Hudson Line), by car (Saw Mill Parkway, Sprain Brook Parkway, Routes 287, 119, 81, and 9, and the Tappan Zee Bridge), and by bus (Beeline).

From NJ - Rockland County

- * NY State Thruway Route 87 - South (Route 287 East)
- * Across Tappan Zee Bridge
- * First Exit after toll (Exit 9)
- * Come down Exit ramp to traffic light (loops back towards river)
- * Make right at light onto Route 9 going North (a/k/a Broadway)
- * Five traffic lights (about 1 mile)
- * At fifth light, make left onto Main Street (7-11 store on left corner)
- * As soon as you make the left, you'll see the theatre marquee on the right.

From CT - Eastern Westchester County

- * Cross Westchester Expressway (Route 287 West)
- * Exits count down (ie. 4,3,2,1)
- * After Exit 1, Route 287 merges with Route 87
- * After merge, take next Exit (sign reads: Exit 9 - Route 9 Last Exit Before Bridge)
- * Come down exit ramp to traffic light - Make left
- * Over crest of hill to next traffic light
- * Make right at light onto Route 9 North (a/k/a Broadway)
- * Go four traffic lights (about 1 mile)
- * At fourth light, make left onto Main Street (7-11 store on left corner)
- * As soon as you make the left, you'll see the theatre marquee on the right.



From NYC - Southern Westchester County

- * Henry Hudson Parkway North to the Saw Mill River Parkway North
- * Exit at Exit 21 West.
- * At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Rte. 119
- * Go to the very end until you can go straight no longer. You will see a Stop & Shop shopping center on your right. At the traffic light, make a right onto Route 9 (a/k/a Broadway)
- * Four traffic lights (about 1 mile)
- * At fourth light, make left onto Main Street (7-11 store on left corner)
- * As soon as you make the left, you'll see the theatre marquee on the right.

OR

- * Major Deegan (Route 87) North
- * To Exit 9 (Sign: Exit 9 - Route 9 Tarrytown Last Exit Before Bridge)
- * Come down Exit ramp to traffic light
- * Make left onto Route 119
- * Over crest of hill to last traffic light
- * Make right at light onto Route 9 (a/k/a Broadway)
- * Four traffic lights (about 1 mile)
- * At fourth light, make left onto Main Street (7-11 store on left corner)
- * As soon as you make the left, you'll see the theatre marquee on the right.

By Train

- * The Music Hall is within walking distance of The Tarrytown Train Station / taxis available at train station
- * The Express and Local Trains run South to Grand Central Station NYC., & North to Poughkeepsie, NY
