TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.

- 1. NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
- 2. NO CAMERAS or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
- 3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
- 4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for <u>absolute emergencies only</u> (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
- 5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
- 6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.



Your Performance Location

The MARYLAND HALL at 801 Chase Street in Annapolis, Maryland.

For TWUSA performances at The Maryland Hall, plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before curtain time. Doors open approximately 30 minutes before curtain time. Groups are seated as they arrive. Please note that large groups that don't arrive together may have to be seated separately.



FROM WASHINGTON DC:

Route 50 East to exit 24 South/Rowe Blvd, bear right at the end of the exit ramp. At the second light, turn right on Taylor Ave. See directions below.

FROM BALTIMORE:

I-97 south to Route 50 East to exit 24 South/Rowe Blvd. turn right at the end of the exit ramp. At the second light, turn right on Taylor Ave. See directions below.

FROM THE EASTERN SHORE:

Route 50 West to exit 24 South/Rowe Blvd towards Annapolis. At the third light, turn right on to Taylor Ave. See directions below.

Take Taylor Ave. until its end at the traffic circle. Go 1/3 of the way around the circle and turn right on Spa Road. Then take the first left on Carraway Lane. Maryland Hall is directly ahead of you. On approaching MHCA, buses will be directed to drop off students at the front entrance to the building. After drop off, buses will be directed where to go and after the show, students will be directed to where the buses are parked.
