TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers. PLEASE NOTE THAT PRIVATE CARS WILL BE CHARGED \$3.00 PER CAR TO PARK. (RATE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.)

- 1. NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
- 2. NO CAMERAS or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
- 3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
- 4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for <u>absolute emergencies only</u> (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
- 5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
- 6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Driving Directions to El Camino College:

From LAX/405 (San Diego Freeway) from the North:

Take the 405 (San Diego Freeway) south to the Redondo Beach Boulevard exit, make a left off the exit onto Redondo Beach Boulevard. The college is on the northwest corner of Redondo Beach and Crenshaw Boulevards (approximately 1.5 miles).

From the 405 (San Diego Freeway) from the South:

Exit the 405 freeway at Crenshaw Boulevard. Make a left off the freeway and a right (north) onto Crenshaw Boulevard. The college is located on the northwest corner of Crenshaw and Redondo Beach Boulevard (approximately 3 miles).


From the 91 (Gardena Freeway) from the East:

The 91 (Gardena Freeway) west will end and become Artesia Boulevard. Continue (west) on Artesia Boulevard until Crenshaw Boulevard. Make a right onto Crenshaw. The college is located on the northwest corner of Crenshaw and Redondo Beach Boulevards (approximately 6 blocks).

From the 110 (Harbor) Freeway from the North or South:


Take the Redondo Beach Boulevard exit. From the northbound 110 make a left onto Redondo Beach and from the southbound 110 make a right turn onto Redondo Beach. The college is located on the northwest corner of Redondo Beach and Crenshaw Boulevards (approximately 5 blocks).


Southbound on 405:

Take Redondo Beach Blvd. exit, left on Redondo Beach Blvd., Stay in the far right lane and take the on-ramp into the college.




Northbound on 405:
