TWUSA GUIDELINES

Teachers and chaperones, in order to make the theatrical experience as pleasurable as possible for your group and all others in attendance, we ask that you review the following information with the students at least one day prior to your field trip. **Subsequent pages contain important information for your group and bus drivers.**

1. **NO FOOD, DRINKS OR SNACKS OF ANY KIND** are permitted in the theater or lobby—this includes bagged lunches and coolers.
2. **NO CAMERAS** or recording equipment of any kind are permitted inside the theater.
3. For many students, this performance will be their first experience with live theater. Instead of talking and whispering during the performance, please wait until after the show to discuss or comment about it. Also, no running, shouting or disruptive behavior at any time before, during, or after the show. Ushers may ask chaperones to remove disruptive children.
4. The performance lasts approximately one hour and restroom and drinking fountain privileges during that time must be reserved for absolute emergencies only (and then, as always, children must be accompanied by an adult).
5. For seating, please follow the instructions of the house staff at all times.
6. All patrons, regardless of age, must purchase a ticket to enter the theater.

Teachers and chaperones, please take an active role in watching over the students in your care and assisting them in maintaining appropriate behavior. We hope you enjoy the show.

Your Performance Location

Davis Theatre at 251 Montgomery Street, Troy University, Montgomery, AL

For TWUSA performances at The Davis Theatre, plan to arrive at least 20 minutes before curtain time. Doors open approximately 45 minutes before curtain time.

Unloading/Parking: The traffic control officers will direct buses on loading/unloading and parking (those directing traffic will be in front of the theatre on the show date). **Patrons travelling in cars will need to park in the parking lot beside the theatre or in a lot marked with Troy signage (the parking spots in front of the theatre will be blocked off for buses.)** If you are traveling by car, please let TheaterWorksUSA know by **three weeks prior** to the show so that the venue staff may inform campus police.

Special Accommodation Requests: Please let TheaterWorksUSA know by three weeks in advance of the show and they will pass the information along to the venue. Please note venue does not have listening devices for the hearing impaired.



Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you of Troy University Davis Theatre's seating procedure. In order for our staff to quickly seat attendees, we need the cooperation of students, teachers, parents and chaperones. Please share and execute the following guidelines with schools as they register for your event. We want to ensure that field trips to Davis Theatre will be a fun and enjoyable experience.

- Do not unload students off the bus or vehicle until the house manager or usher gives them permission to unload.
- Groups will be seated on a first come, first serve basis.
- Groups will not be seated until everyone is present.
- Book bags or large carrying bags are not permitted in theatre.
- Foods and Drinks are not permitted in theatre.
- Recording or taking pictures during a performance is not permitted.
- Line up students, teachers, parents and chaperones according to how they would like to be seated inside the theatre. If they do not have time to line up, please allow our ushers to seat their group and then they may reposition them.
- If children need to use the restroom, please wait until after they have been seated and then take them to the restroom.
- Groups are not permitted to walk on stage.

Coming from Birmingham and other points north of Montgomery:

Interstate 65 South into Montgomery
Exit on CLAY STREET (Clay St. is One Way going RIGHT... so...)
Go straight one block and turn LEFT onto HERRON STREET (Herron St. is One Way going LEFT)
Go "up over the hill, around the curve left and down." The second traffic light is MOLTON STREET.
Turn RIGHT onto MOLTON STREET.
At the next traffic light, you are at the intersection of Molton and Montgomery Streets. The theatre is directly across left.

Coming from Greenville and other points south of Montgomery:

Interstate 65 North into Montgomery
Exit on HERRON STREET (Herron St. is One Way going RIGHT)
Go "up over the hill, around the curve left and down." The second traffic light is MOLTON STREET.
Turn RIGHT onto MOLTON STREET.
At the next traffic light, you are at the intersection of Molton and Montgomery Streets. The theatre is directly across left.

Coming from Auburn and other points east of Montgomery:

Interstate 85 South into Montgomery
Exit onto Interstate 65 North (Birmingham) ** In the ramp is the HERRON STREET EXIT **
Exit on HERRON STREET (Herron St. is One Way going RIGHT)
Go "up over the hill, around the curve left and down." The second traffic light is MOLTON STREET.
Turn RIGHT onto MOLTON STREET.
At the next traffic light, you are at the intersection of Molton and Montgomery Streets. The theatre is directly across left.

Coming from Troy and other points southeast of Montgomery:

Highway 231 North to Montgomery
Turn onto Taylor Road (Hwy 271)
Turn on Interstate 85 South into Montgomery
Exit onto Interstate 65 North (Birmingham) ** In the ramp is the HERRON STREET EXIT **
Exit on HERRON STREET (Herron St. is One Way going RIGHT)
Go "up over the hill, around the curve left and down." The second traffic light is MOLTON STREET.
Turn RIGHT onto MOLTON STREET.
At the next traffic light, you are at the intersection of Molton and Montgomery Streets. The theatre is directly across left.

Coming from Selma and other points west of Montgomery:

Highway 80 East to Montgomery
Interstate 65 North into Montgomery
Exit on HERRON STREET (Herron St. is One Way going RIGHT)
Go "up over the hill, around the curve left and down." The second traffic light is MOLTON STREET.
Turn RIGHT onto MOLTON STREET.
At the next traffic light, you are at the intersection of Molton and Montgomery Streets. The theatre is directly across left.
